

Mining Engineer: Load & Haul

- 1. Optimised and improved mining processes
 - a. Analyse and measure mining processes to identify improvement opportunities
 - b. Manage loading and hauling operations to achieve budgeted plans and schedule compliance metrics
 - c. Optimise shovel and truck usage to achieve hauling targets
 - d. Payload capacity analysis for hauling and loading when this is not achieved
 - e. Optimise efficient cycle times
 - f. Report substandard road conditions to minimise haul truck damage

 - a. Manage the section's expenditure within the approved budget parameters to ensure effective cost control and savings
- 5. People management
 - a. Establish a performance culture, characterised by continuous improvement


